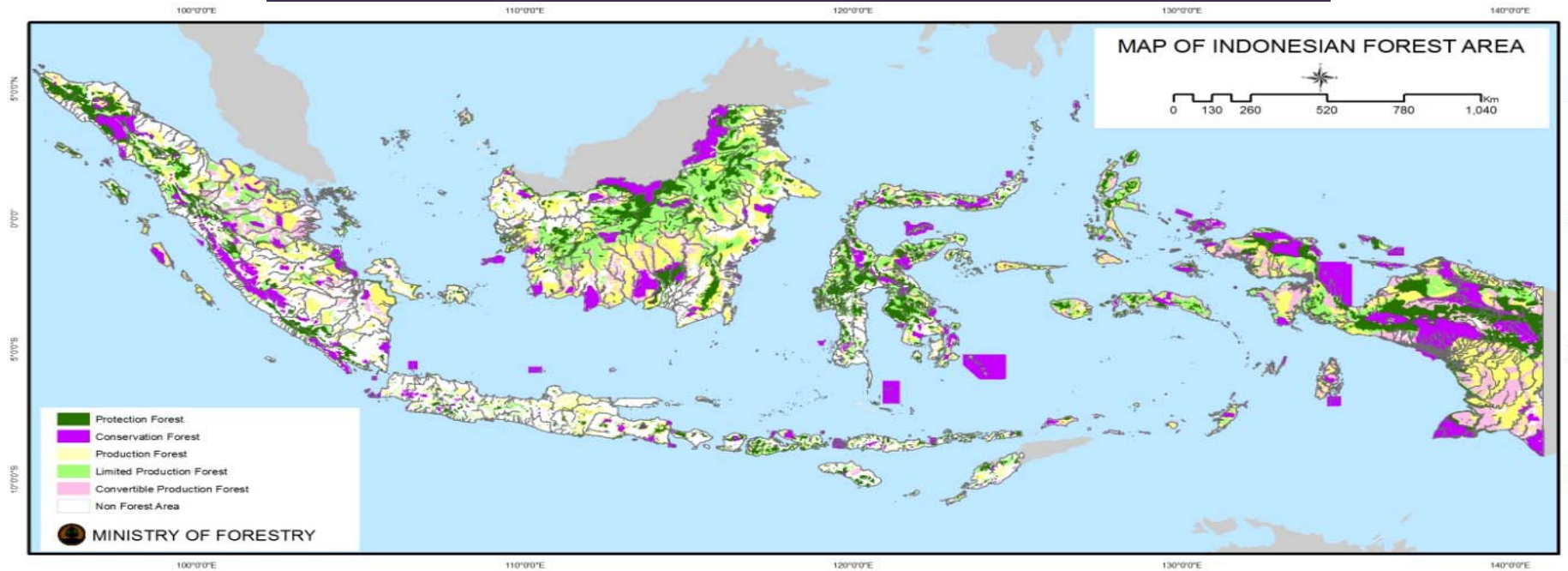

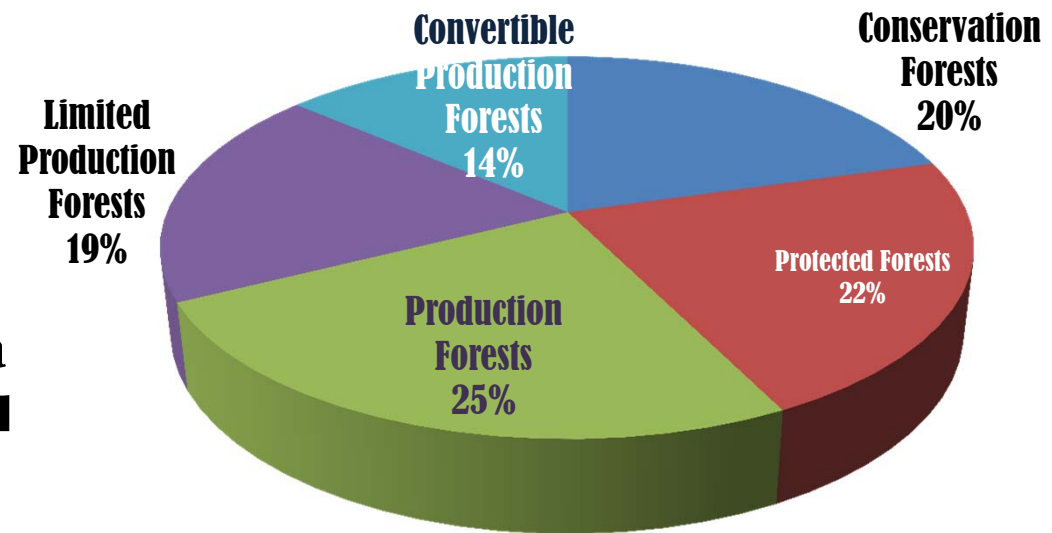
The Indonesian Forest



More than 17,000 islands

as of December 2012 designation

- **181.157 million ha land area**
- **134.430 mi ha of forest land**
(70% of landmass)





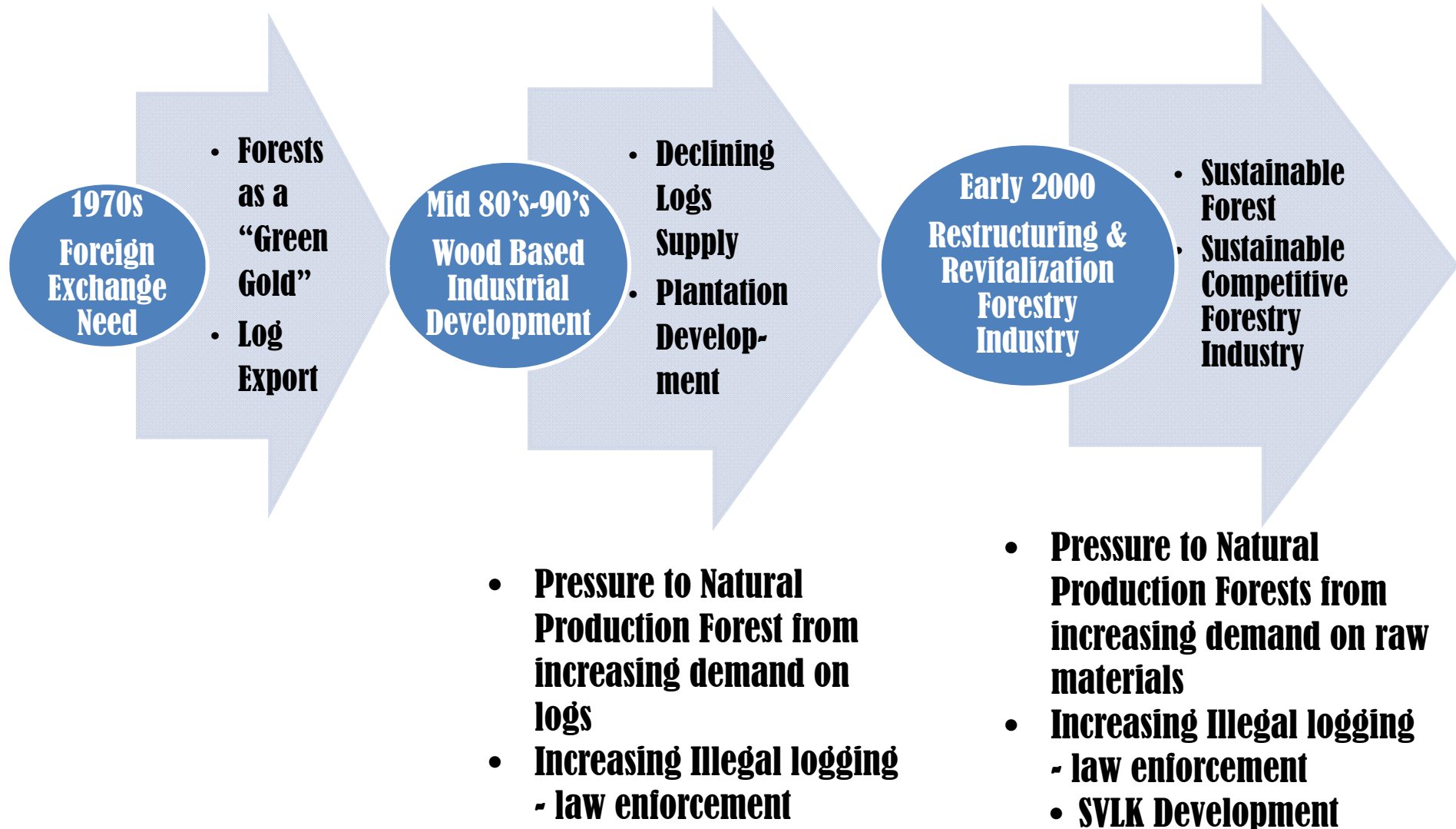
Indonesia's Forest Resources

- **Illegal Logging Threaten Sustainability Forest Resources.**

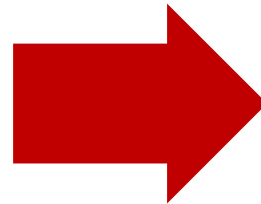

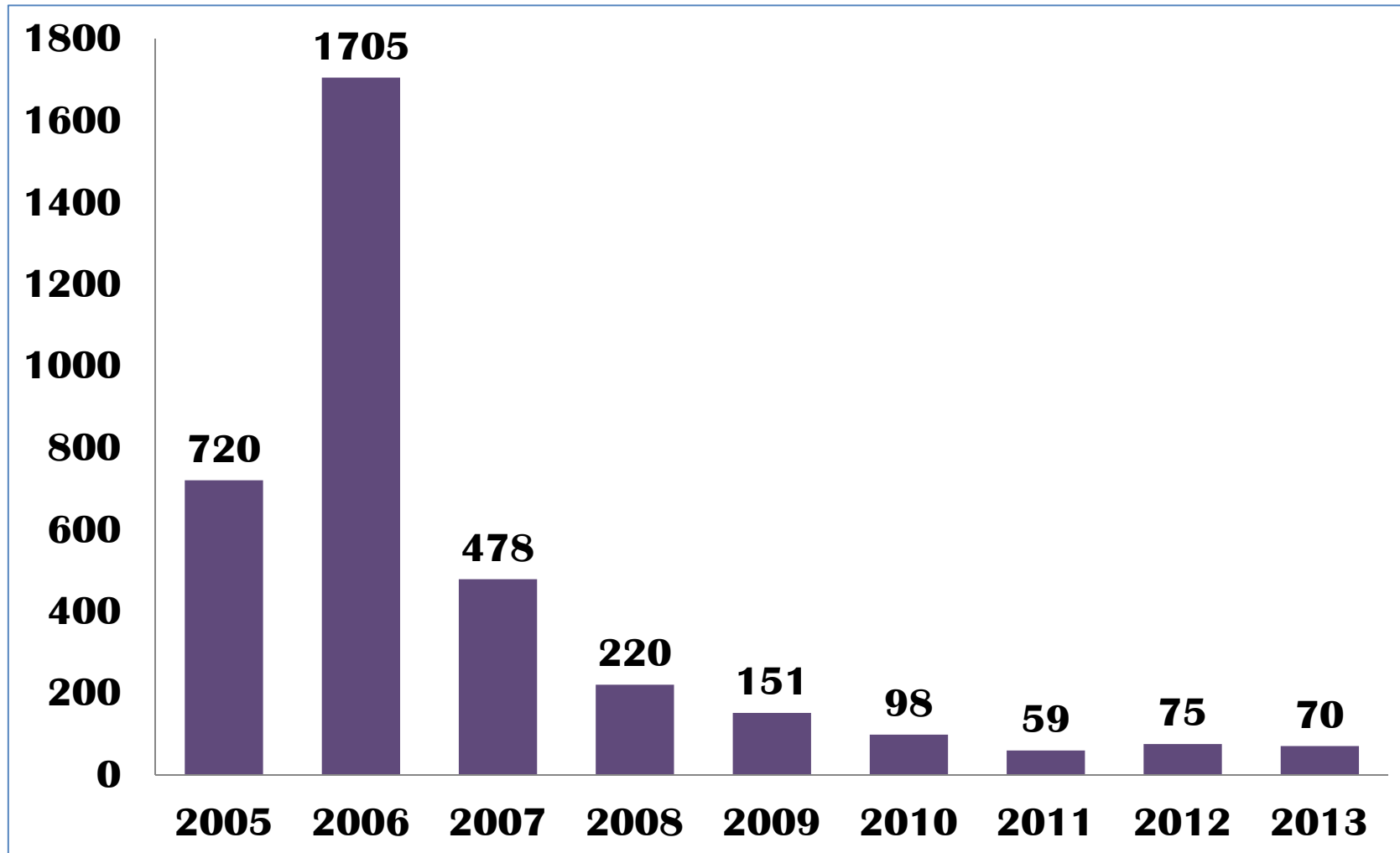

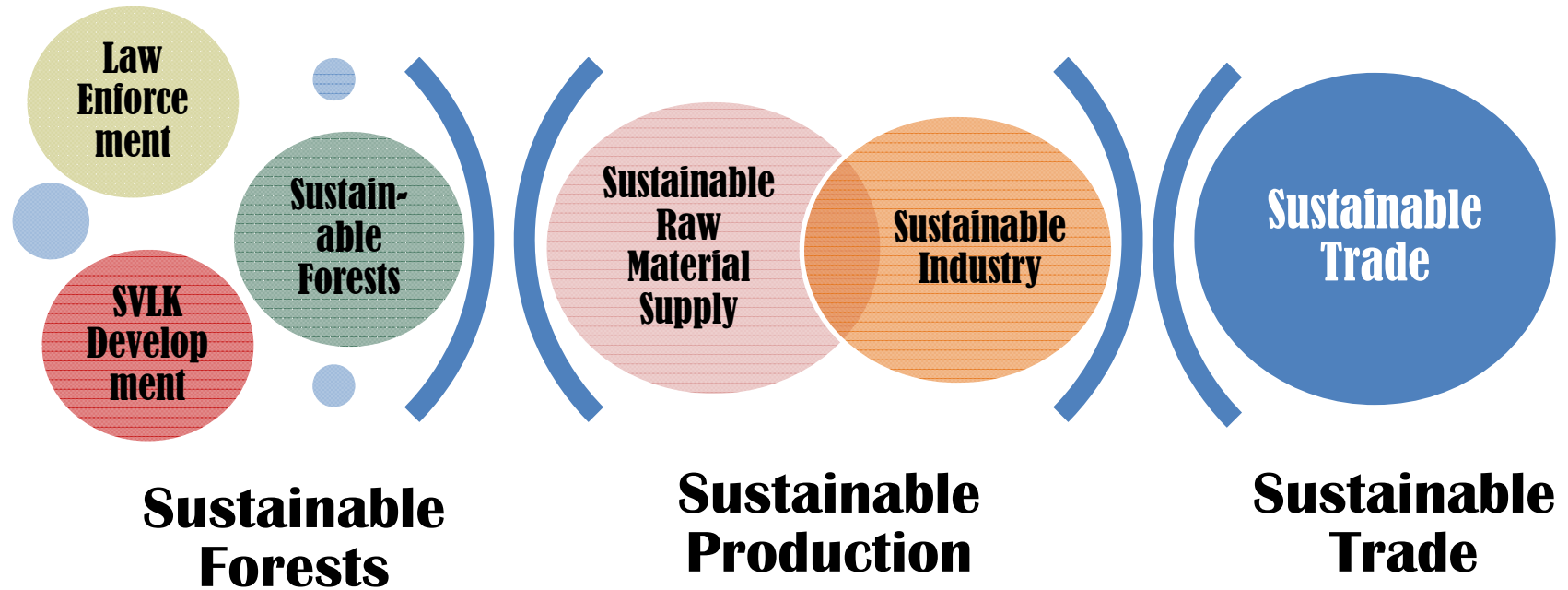
Illegal Logging trend in Indonesia, 2005 - 2013

- **SVLK provide unique experiences to customer**

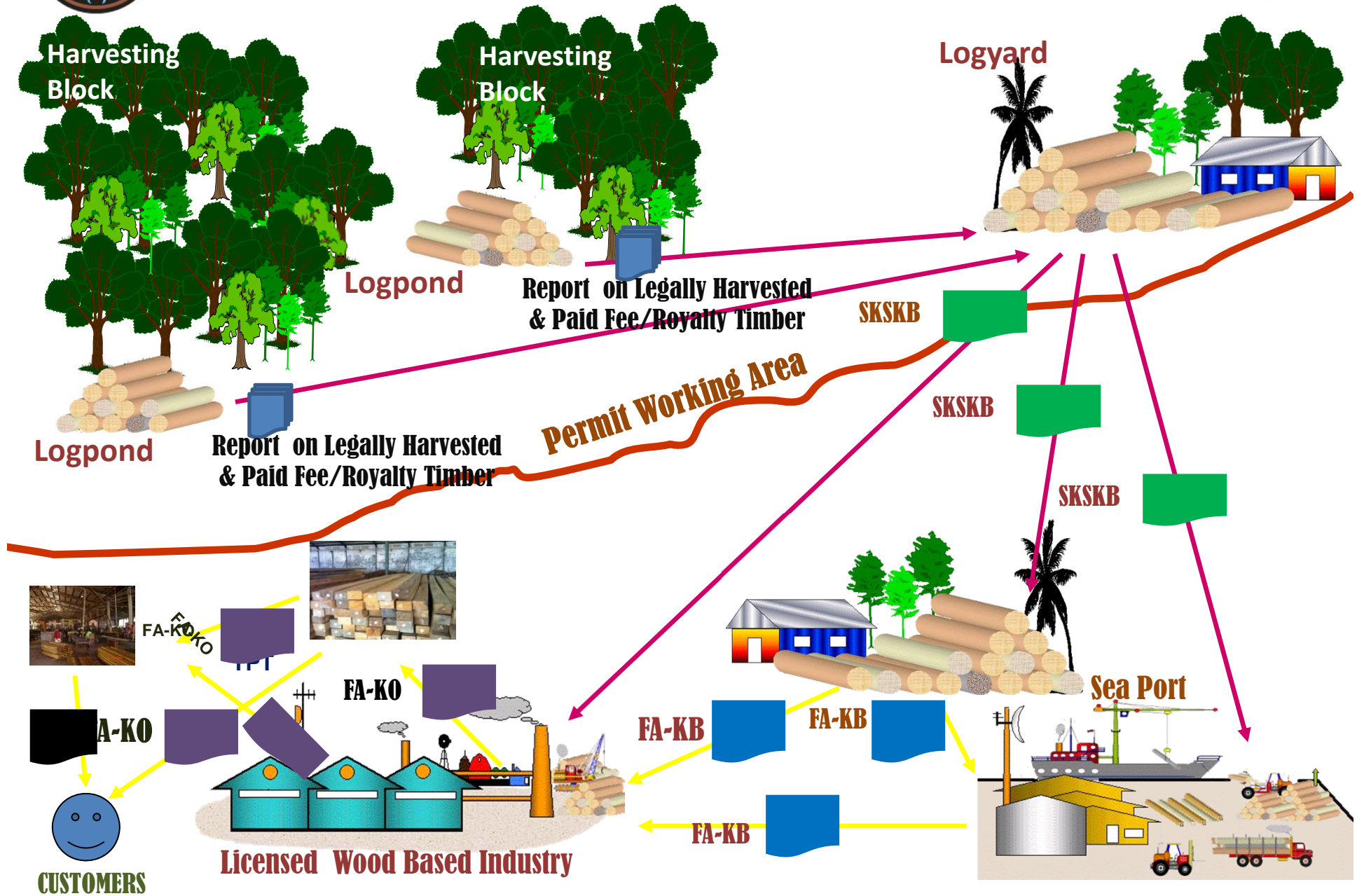

- **based on ISO 17011 (International Accreditation - PAC, IAF, APLAC, ILAC)**

NGO/CSO

- **independent forest monitoring (IFM)**
- **23-09-2010, JPIK (IFM Network) was established consisting 29 NGOs, perform monitoring public service in forestry sector.**

CAB (LP&VI)

- **Independent Assessment/Verification Bodies.**
- **Accredited by ISO 17021 & ISO/IEC Guide 65**

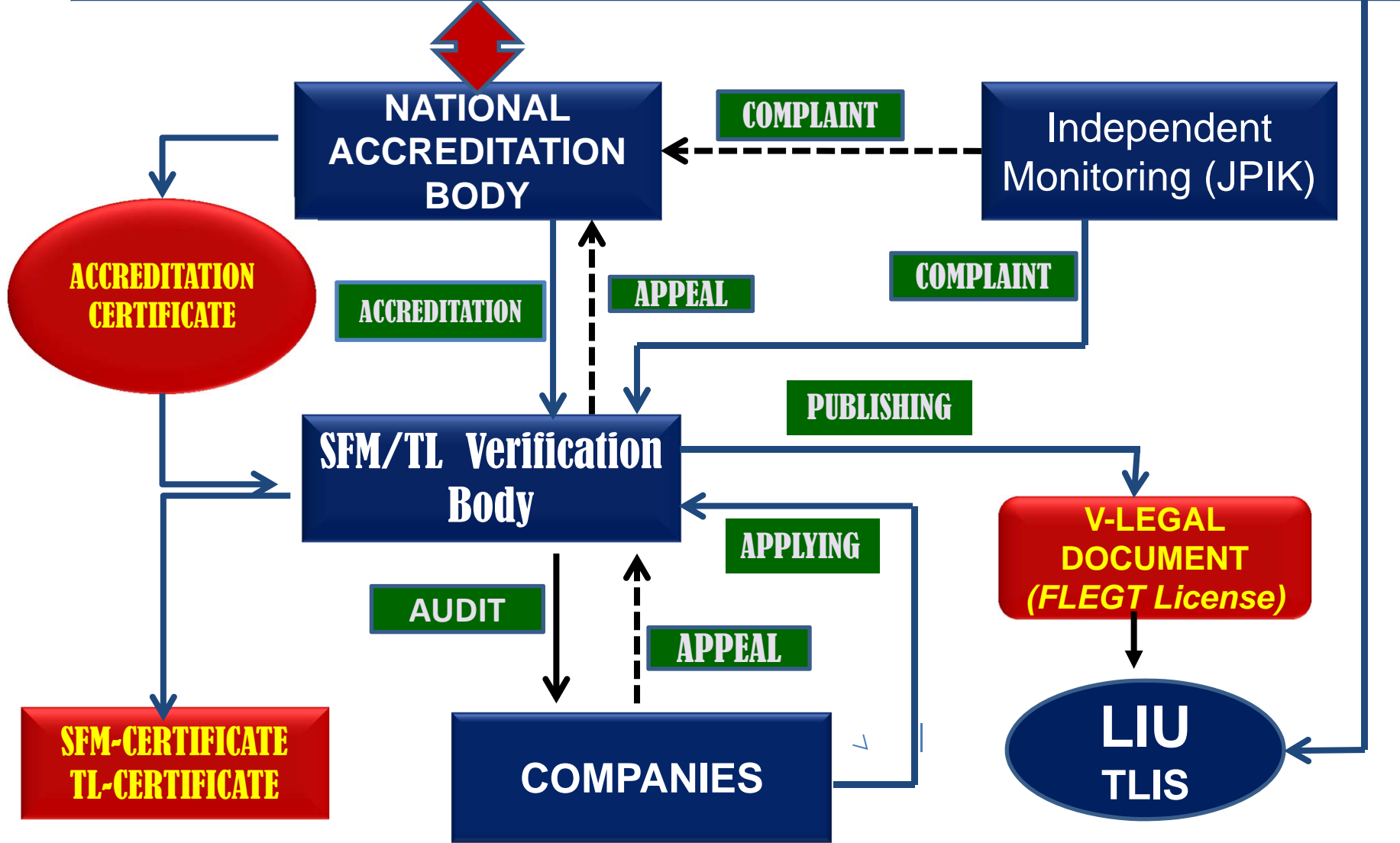

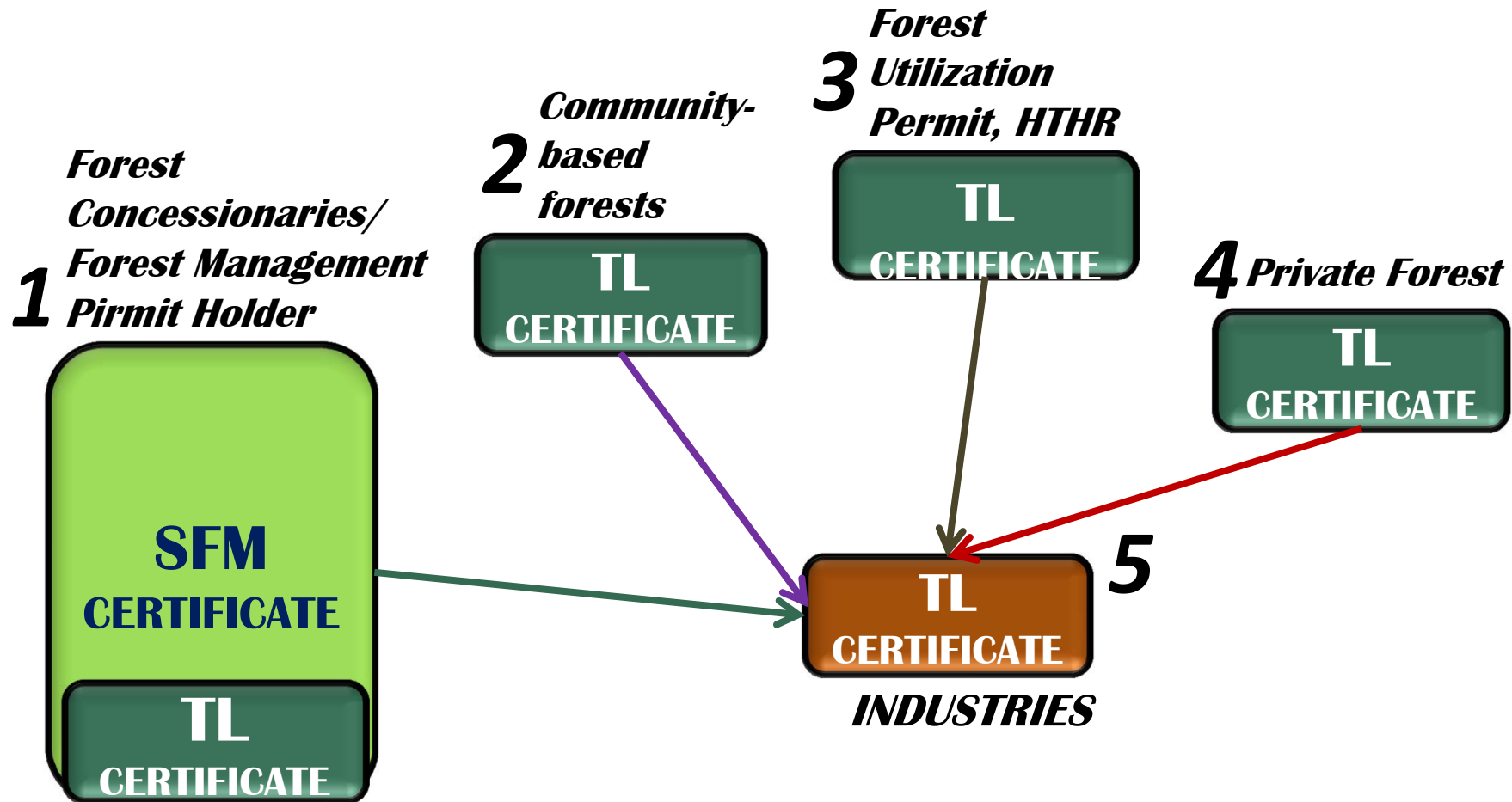

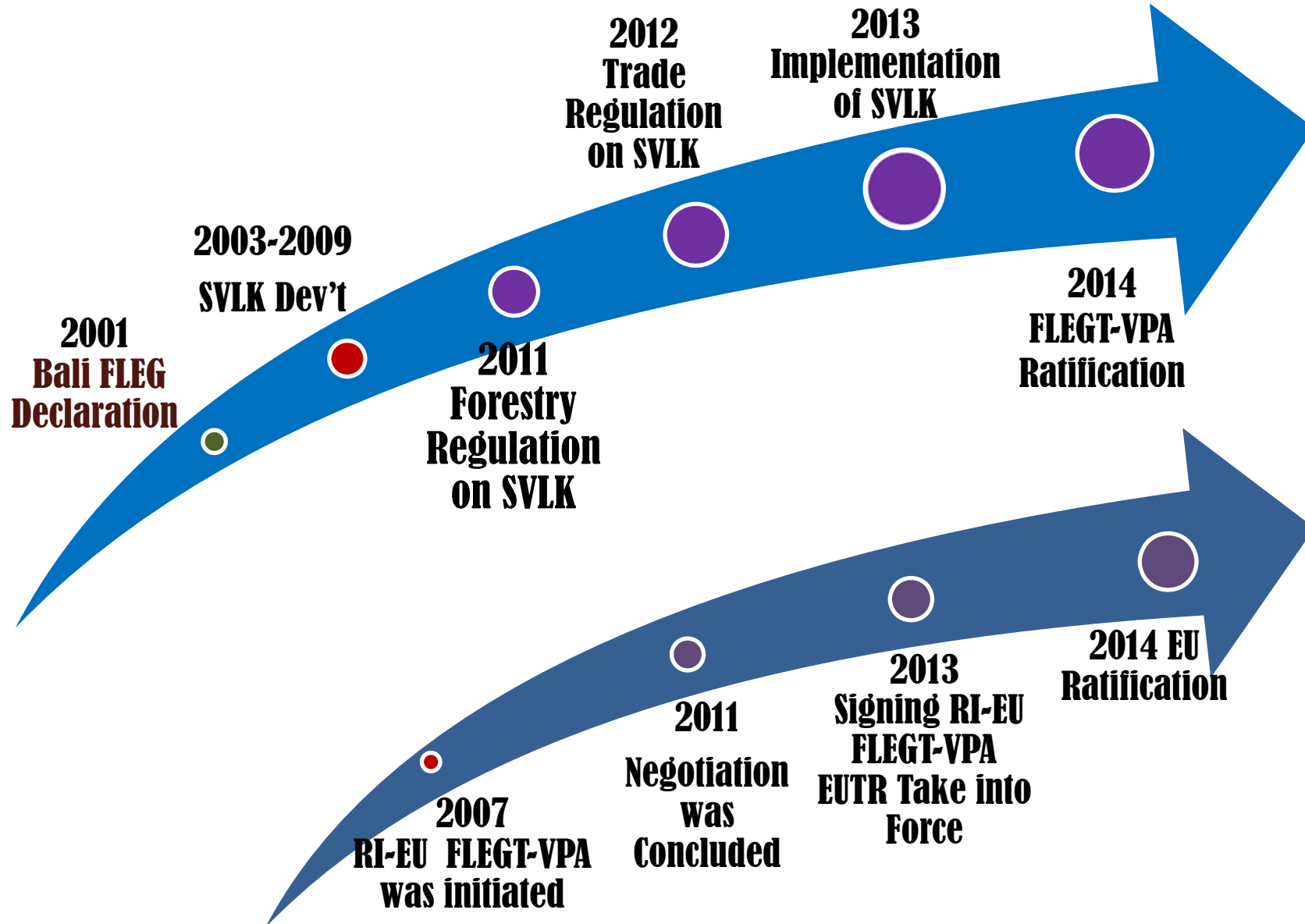


Justification For Indonesia Entering FLEGT - VPA

- **No Demand – No Supply for Illegal Timber**
- **Illegal logging relate to Illegal Trade**
- **Producing Countries can not combat illegal logging without support consuming countries from demand side**
- **FLEGT-VPA demonstrate cooperation between producing countries and consuming countries to combat illegal logging and its associated trade**

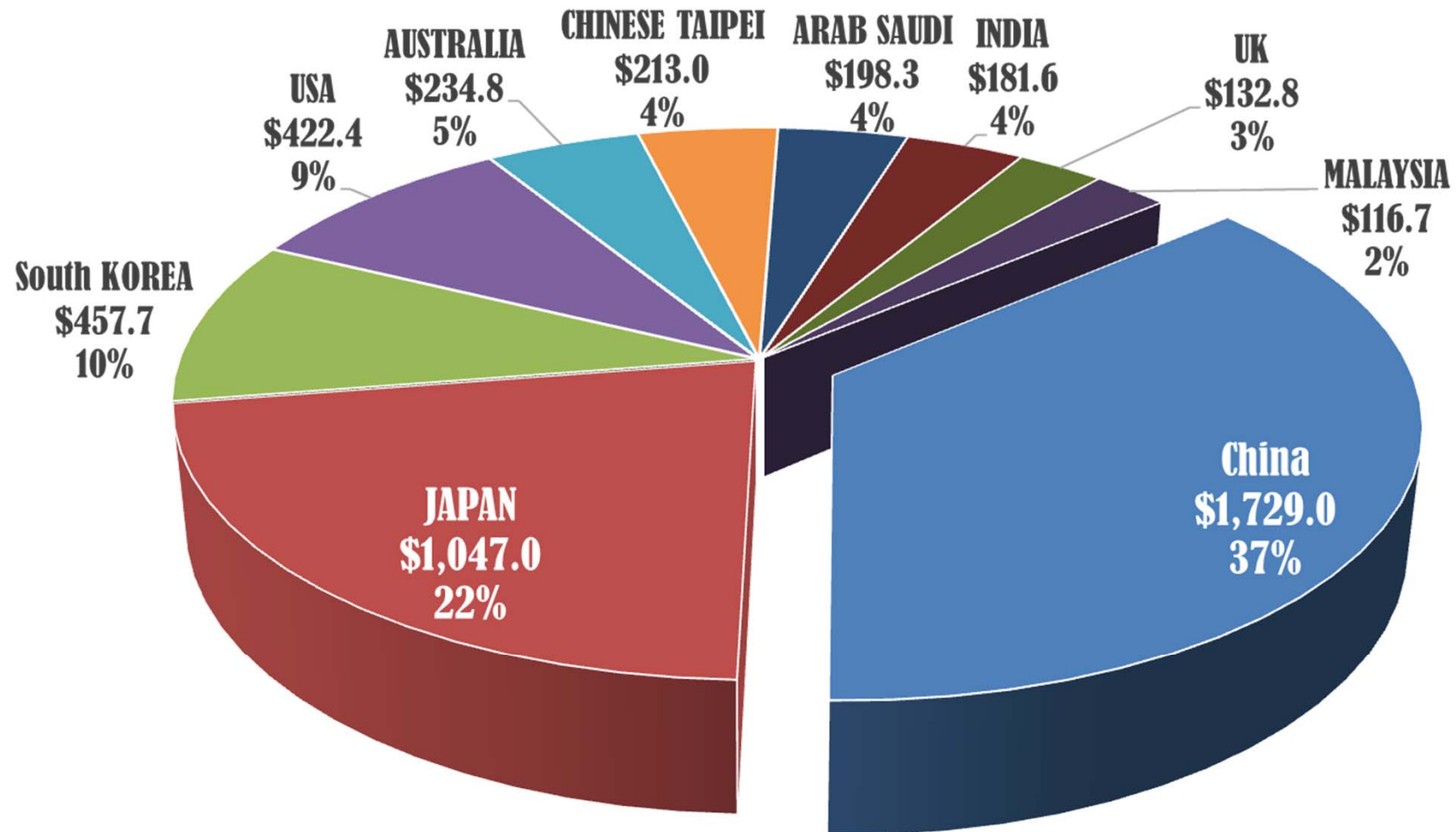
