Carbon footprint

- ISO/TC 207/SC 7 held plenary meeting on 30 May 2014 in Panama
- Presented results of survey on use of TS 14067
- Created an Ad Hoc Group to analyse trade impacts and suggest way forward
- Possible revision of TS 14067 towards end of 2015





Conclusions

- There is already a good level of knowledge of the ISO/TS 14067, both in developed and developing countries.
- Many countries already accept it as National TS and more have the intention to do it in the next years.
- An upgrade to an International Standard is welcomed by the majority of the NSBs.
- There is the perception that this tool will have an high or medium level of interest from the market.
- More information is needed at different level to avoid any risk of misunderstanding or misuse of the standard.

Water footprint

- ISO/TC 207/SC 5 held plenary meeting on 30 May 2014 in Panama
- DIS 14046.2 public enquiry results presented
- WG addressed comments from DIS 14046.2 consultation
- No substantial changes were made
- Decision to go for publication (expected 1 August 2014)
